Expected dress code	Additional guidance
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Suit or smart <b>tailored</b> trousers.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>No denim.</li><li>No casual trousers or leggings.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Smart skirt/ dress.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Skirts and dresses must be of an <b>appropriate length</b>.</li><li>No tube/ bandage skirt or bandage dress of any length.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Smart shirt with tie or smart blouse, (tie is optional in the summer term).</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>No polo shirt.</li><li>No t-shirts.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Smart shoes.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>No trainers/ pumps/ mules/ sliders.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Smart jumper or cardigan (optional for the cold weather).</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>No sports top.</li><li>No hoodies/ sweatshirts.</li><li>No logos.</li></ul>

In addition to the above:

- no hats or coats to be worn inside
- no extreme hair or makeup
- no headphones/ air pods to be worn outside of the Sixth Form area or library.

**Students who arrive at Sixth Form inappropriately or too casually dressed will be asked to return home to change and will need to make up for any learning time missed.**
