Diversity Day on Monday 17 July 2023

On Monday 17 July, we will be hosting our first Diversity Day. This is a day of celebration of our diverse school community. We hope that this will be an opportunity for staff and students to share their culture and heritage. This will be through wearing clothes, sharing food and or performing a song, dance or poem, which reflects their heritage. In the afternoon, we will be having a picnic and sponsored walk.

Diversity picnic: students are asked to contribute to a tutor group picnic. This is a chance to share food that represents their culture. If students are making their own food to be shared with the group, it should be clearly labelled with the ingredients. There will also be an ice cream van on site for the afternoon. Students will be able to purchase an ice cream if they wish.

Sponsored walk: All students will be provided with a sponsorship form to bring home. In the afternoon, our whole school community will be walking the parameter of our playing fields to raise money for local charities and our student leadership team school improvement fund. If students complete one lap of the playing fields, they will receive a token that they can exchange for one of the stalls and activities organised for the afternoon. If students would like to raise even more money, they can complete a second circuit to receive a second token. Everyone in school will then spend the afternoon enjoying the games and stalls, which Year 12 students have organised.

Each stall/ activity will cost 50p. These include inflatable slides, games stalls and obstacle courses.

Students will have the opportunity to change into their PE kit on the day for the sponsored walk if they would like to. The school day will finish at the normal time of 3.05pm.
