Free Holiday Clubs, **Experiences and Food**



This Easter school holiday, children and young people who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals (or who meet our other eligibility criteria*) can benefit from an amazing range of free holiday clubs and experiences.

This booklet shows some of the wide collection of activities available, when and where they are being held, and the age ranges. A meal is provided at all clubs on each of the days they are running. Check our webpages for to view all the activities available this Easter.

How do I book?

Families who are eligible will receive a letter in the post inviting them to book. In this letter, you will have your child's HAF code, which will be a reference number on all your bookings.

There are just a few steps needed to book your child onto HAF activities and experiences. These are:

- 1. Make sure you've got a Coventry City Council My Account set up www.myaccount.coventry.gov.uk
- 2. Have your HAF code ready
- 3. Add your child to the booking system
- 4. Decide what to book go to our HAF webpages for more detailed information about activities
- 5. Book your child onto the activities

When you've done this, you'll receive a confirmation email. Just contact the provider if your child has any additional needs, or requirements. When it's time for an activity, just turn up and enjoy!

How do HAF credits and bookings work?

Each eligible child has a total of four credits which are used to book activities. Some clubs are open to Book 1 day at a time, whilst others require children to attend every day that week. Under each club description, you will find information on whether you can Book 1 day at a time, or if you must book a block of multiple days at a time. The number in the red circle next to the session names

indicates how many credits each session is worth.

Coventry experiences are indicated with (E) and are limited to one per child. Clubs that are specifically for children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) are marked with (s) and are ONLY open to

Special Educational Needs and Disabilities and Inclusion

HAF activities are welcoming and inclusive environments for children and young people. If your child has additional needs, we highly recommend that you contact the provider delivering each activity as soon as possible to discuss how these needs could be met.

'All About Me'

Prior to activities, we encourage you to have a conversation with our providers using the 'All About Me' approach. By talking through the questions below, providers can record useful information about your child's needs to ensure that activities can be made as inclusive as possible for all those who attend.

The questions are as follows:

- · What are your strengths?
- What are your needs?
- · Do vou know anvone else coming to the activity/club? (e.g. children or staff) If so, who?
- How do you like to communicate?
- · How do you understand instructions?
- What can make you feel upset?
- What can help you calm down?
- · What are your favourite things to do?
- · Will anyone come with you to the club? If so, who?
- Is there anything else we should know?

We know that many families face tight budgets across Coventry. More and more people are feeling the effects of the increasing costs of living, and this can put pressure on feeding your family. Nutritious food is at the heart of the HAF programme. That's why each of the activities has a free meal included.

Lots of support is available from many different organisations to help you manage the cost of food pressures.

Accessing food support

Food Banks and Social Supermarkets are there to support households in need. Food Banks work on a referral basis and can provide emergency food parcels. For long-term support, you can pay approximately £5 per week and receive £15-£20 worth of food from a Social Supermarket. They are located all around the city. 


School uniform and clothing
