- > Unit 3: Historical Themes- Civil Rights in the USA 1865-1992 (40%)
- Unit 4: Independent personal Study (20%) This is a piece of personal research that you begin working on in year 12. You then produce a 4000 word answer to a question that is designed by your teacher or even by yourself.
